Additional 1st Century Passover Information

The Passover celebration takes about 2 ½ hours to complete. We suggest the starting time be 6:30 p.m. on weekdays. Other times (including weekends) are available when requested and approved in advance. The event is comprised of several varied sections so that no one will be bored. We have two multimedia presentations, a full meal with time for everyone to visit and relax, and times for teaching and explanations concerning Passover. This program is geared for people ages 13 and above.

What we provide:

We provide Multimedia presentations

We provide a complete 1st century meal.

We provide all cooking utensils, and table service.

We provide explanations of the daily customs and Passover customs of the time.

We provide teaching that will clearly show Christ in the Passover.

What you must provide:

1. The meeting place for that has sufficient room for the number attending.
2. Tables set up with paper tablecloth
3. Kitchen facilities for food preparation. (We provide cooking utensils, and table service.)
4. Volunteers (number determined by the size of your group) before the Passover celebration to help carry in supplies and to help set up food. (Volunteers must arrive 1 ½ hours before the event time)
5. Volunteers (depending on group size) after the Passover celebration to help with clean up including cleaning tables, washing a few food serving items, and trash disposal. (Approx. time needed, 30 minutes after the completed presentation.

The cost of a Passover Celebration.

1. The cost per person for all attendees of the Passover celebration is \$25.00 (minimum of 40 attendees). We will hold a Passover celebration for less than 35 attendees with a minimum fee of \$1,000.
2. For Passover celebrations more than 50 miles from Grand Rapids, Michigan, there is also a round-trip mileage charge of \$.60 per mile from our offices in Grand Rapids, Michigan.
